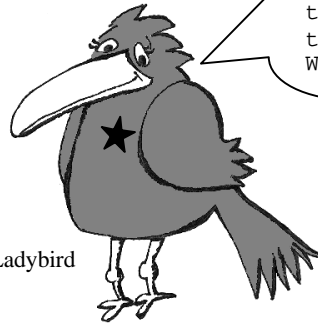


Mission #2005: Impostors!

Assignment:
